

Catalan Review **Submission Guidelines**

All manuscripts to be considered for publication in the Catalan Review must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Follow MLA style (7th edition) with three exceptions: a) in the list of works cited you do not need to write print or web after each entry; b) please leave one space before and after m dash; c) please mark elisions with ... (suspension points with no spaces in between). If you need help with MLA style, you may consult the following web resources: http://www.mla.org/style_faq1, <http://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/747/1/>.
- Manuscripts must be double-spaced, with 1-inch margins and 12-point Times New Roman. Number pages consecutively. Indent the beginning of each paragraph.
- Include an abstract in English of approximately 150-200 words at the beginning of your article.
- Use endnotes instead of footnotes.
- For the Works Cited / Referències section, please use the MLA format, except for the following cases: 1) Begin the section with Works Cited (centered, in small capitals); 2) when two works by the same author are included use —(em dash) instead of ---.; 3) when you cite the place of publication, use the name of the place in the language in which the article is written (e.g., Londres for an article written in Catalan, London for an article written in English); 4) for works in Catalan, place periods and commas outside quotation marks (e.g., No comprenc la paraula “amor”.); for works in English, place periods and commas outside the quotation marks (e.g., I do not understand the word “love”).
- Manuscripts that do not follow the MLA format and the Catalan Review guidelines will not be accepted for evaluation.
